SJS is sponsored by The Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities. They exist to help young people find work and explore options. We're here to HELP you.

To qualify for SJS services, you must be:

- ⇒ 15-30 years of age
- ⇒ Planning to return to school in the fall
- ⇒ Eligible to work in Canada
- ⇒ Hired by an employer to whom you're NOT related to
- ⇒ But, if you're not, ask anyway. We may have other ideas for you!

SJS supports summer employment for students:

- ◇ We provide information, knowledge and skills through our **Resource Centre**, to help students find a job on their own.
- ◇ Employers can have access to youth who are ready and willing to work in the summer.

If you don't know what kind of job you'd like to do, we'll help you figure that out. Together we'll explore your options and strengths to find out what areas of work you might enjoy.



Summer Jobs Service helps students get work experience, starting in April each year. Students and employers can begin their summer job search or recruitment as early as January. Students can access the Resource and Information Service (RI) iyear-round to help them plan for summer employment while still in school.
